

EVALUATING ENGLISH CEFR (COMMON EUROPEAN FRAMEWORK OF REFERENCE) LEVEL OF FINAL YEAR POLYTECHNIC STUDENTS THROUGH MOBILE ASSISTED LANGUAGE TESTING TOOL

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ABSTRACT

In these gadgets driven days, our hunger for electronic devices & technology is growing fast. In every field of human life technological devices are developed & updated in the last few decades. Among them mobile phone has brought satisfaction in human life especially in students it is more popular tool. Without this device they can't imagine their life. Though parents & teachers are against of carrying mobiles in the classrooms as they distract students from their learning still students are carried away by its applications. This paper exhibits the benefits of using mobile phones for learning purposes mainly improving technical students 'English language Skills' through BRITISH COUNCIL English Score which is an online tool for testing English level with Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR) globally recognized language proficiency standard. I conducted English proficiency test of final year polytechnic students with British Council app which was analyzed in this paper. The paper concludes with findings of test & with some recommendations for improvement.

The BRITISH COUNCIL English Score which is (having globally recognized CEFR scale for describing English language proficiency) an English language exam for students, teachers and job seekers was used to conduct the test and collect the data.

Thanks to the British Council English Score group for providing free access to British Council's Free English Test app to every student.

Data Collection:

About hundred Polytechnic students were randomly selected for the British Council's English Score test. The selected students were given detailed explanation about the test by the researcher. Having downloaded the British Council English Score app on their mobiles all selected students took the test by following the instructions given on the app and recorded their score with level and analysis given by the app. The researcher noted the score and analyzed the data for further assistance to improvement.

Result, Analysis and interpretation of data:

The students English language skills were tested through the Smart phones using BRITISH COUNCIL English Score tool and the score was recorded as indicated by the tool. The score was as follows



The above score was given by British Council English Score test based on the performance of learners. Students from Third Year Diploma in Mechanical Engg, Civil Engg, Electronics & Telecommunication Engg & Computer Engg were given the standard test based on CEFR level for English proficiency using smartphones. Number of learners with Pre- Beginner A0 level & Beginner A1 level results were 26 & 04 out of 100, number of learners with Elementary A2 level result were 38 out of 100, number of learners with Intermediate B1 result were 27 out of 100 and number of learners with upper intermediate result were 05 out of 100. No learners have achieved Advanced C1 & Proficient C2 level result. Beginner level students need to be improve their English skills by practicing more in all levels. Elementary & Intermediate learners have to take extra efforts to become proficient in English language. They have to improve their LSRW with vocabulary & grammar. The students showed lot of enthusiasm in taking up this test & later determined to make use of mobiles as a tool for learning language.

Findings of the Study:

Findings related to the above status of English communication skills of UG level technical students are as follow.

- 1. The learners with pre-beginner & beginner English are 30% who came under poor category, with Elementary English are 38%, intermediate & upper Intermediate English are27% & 5% who come under average category.
- 2. Inappropriate approach to teaching learning process.
- 3. The learners came from such a family background where most of the parents do not speak, read or write English.
- 4. Inadequate vocabulary knowledge shows poor performance in test.
- 5. The preconceived notions about English as difficult & confusing.
- 6. Dominance of mother tongue at home & in the neighborhood, they are taking less efforts in learning English.
- 7. Lack of confidence & motivation in speaking English, though they have basic knowledge of English.
- 8. Inadequate qualified English teachers & improper teaching methods.
- 9. More focus on Mathematics & technical subjects in technical education.
- 10. Learners do exam oriented study
- 11. Inadequate provision in language laboratory, language software should be regularly updated utilized properly.

Suggestions to improve Communication Skills for students, teachers and Job seekers:

- 1. Self motivation, make conscious effort to communicate in English only
- 2. Learn words through situations.
- 3. Read English newspaper daily to get acquainted with new vocabulary also updating oneself with current affairs.
- 4. Develop technical vocabulary.
- 5. Exposing to online learning apps of communication skills.
- 6. Focus should be on language learning skills rather than on completion of syllabus.
- 7. English lovers try to maintain a diary and write daily a new words, new phrases that they come across in a day.
- 8. Be good listener first, then only you will be good communicator. Listen more than you speak. listening helps to familiarize with rhythms & intonation of English.
- 9. Reading loud which improves the pronunciation, familiarize with IPA sounds by listening native speakers of English as imitation plays vital role in effective communication.
- 10. Watch the movies & TV programs in English through which you can learn vocabulary, idioms, slang & pronunciation.
- 11. Talk to yourself in English narrating your actions in English can be an effective way of spoken English.
